| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A backpack (some schools do not permit rolling backpacks because of space considerations)</li><li>• Ballpoint pens</li><li>• No. 2 pencils</li><li>• Colored pencils</li><li>• Pencil sharpener (the ones with a top for shavings can be a lot less messy)</li><li>• Highlighters</li><li>• Large pink erasers</li><li>• Box of crayons</li><li>• Water-based markers</li><li>• Notebooks</li><li>• 3-ring binder</li></ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Loose-leaf notebook paper</li><li>• Pocket folders</li><li>• Drawing paper</li><li>• Construction paper</li><li>• A ruler with English and metric measurements</li><li>• White glue</li><li>• Glue sticks (at least 3 for the year)</li><li>• Scissors (blunt end for young children, sharper points for older children)</li><li>• Scotch tape</li><li>• Tissues</li><li>• Small bottle of hand sanitizer</li></ul> |

Check with teachers to see how complicated the calculator needs to be. Some classes may require graphing calculators, while others may not need it.</li></ul> |
